# HOW TO QUALIFY 2025

There are currently three ways to qualify for the Manitoba Provincial Championships:

0	QUALIFIER	Any current MDAI member in good standing can compete to qualify for the Provincial Championships. Each competitor must complete at least one Zone Qualifier / Event.  Each zone will dictate the cost, format and scheduling of Qualifiers. Ū	T O P R A N K	Top Eight Men & Top Eight Women on the Official MDAI Ranking List on December 31, 2024 may opt to Buy-In to the Provincials of that year. Full MDAI/NDFC Membership for 2024/2025 must be purchased on or before that date.  The current Buy-In is \$150.00 due February 28, 2025.  Payments can be by Interac e-transfer to mb darts@shaw.ca.

# **PROVINCIALS 2025**

\*\*\* DartConnect will be used to run the Provincials.

All competitors must sing up for a free DartConnect Account - This will give you real-time results, schedules and board calls.

The number of players going to Provincials for each zone will be based on number of players participating at their qualifiers.



## **NOTES FOR PLAYERS / ZONE CHAIRS**

- Complete results for all qualifying events must be sent within 48 hours to the Provincial Director - provincialdirector@manitobadarts.ca
- FEBRUARY 28, 2025
  - Last day for players to withdraw without extenuating circumstances.
  - o Zone Chairs must have final list of qualifiers to the Provincial Director.
  - All Players' Provincial fees must be sent to the Treasurer (\$60.00 per player through Zones) - mb darts@shaw.ca
- Full NDFC Dress Code in effect for the entire Provincial Championships.

### From NDFC Rule Book © NDFC 2023 -

#### 19. PLAYING ATTIRE and HEADGEAR

- 19.1 Players must wear dress pants or skirts and a collared shirt while playing on stage or in a staged event.
- 19.2 Headgear and electronic listening devices shall not be worn without prior permission of the Organizers, while playing in any event. Such permission must be given to players whose religious or moral duties require that the head be covered or to players with a medical condition verified by a physician (e.g. hearing impairment, Alope-cia Areata, chemotherapy or radiation treatment).

- For Mixed, Men's and Women's Doubles
- Each of the 8 Men and 8 Women will write down their top Choices for Partners (Up to 8).
- Lists to be given in Confidence to the Provincial Director.
- Pairs will be made based on preferences submitted by the Provincial Director as best as is possible.
- One Other Board Member Will Sign Off on the Pairings as Fairly and Ethically Assigned Based on the Submitted Lists.
- Choice Precedence will alternate years Odd-Women / Even-Men
